Rules and Regulations- Clearwater View Inc.

The following rules and regulations have been adopted by the Governor of the Clearwater View Inc.. The observance of these rules an regulations will insure the fullest use of the Club to each member.

Membership

Membership card are not transferable. Membership cards must be presented at designated entrances for admission to the grounds and facilities of the Club at all times. Lost membership cards will be replaces only upon payment of \$20.00. All lost cards must be reported promptly. The Club opens Memorial Day Weekend and closes Labor Day. Pool and private beach open June 15th of the respectful year.

- 1. Guests may be admitted to the Beach Club only when accompanied by a member in good standing and upon registering and paying the established fees. Any member who fails to register his or her guest may be subjected to suspension from Club membership.
- 2. Members will be held responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- 3. Persons not eligible for membership may not be admitted to the Club as a guest.
- 4. The Club reserves the right to respect or withdraw guest privileges at any time.
- 5. Parking of guests' cars is subject to parking fees as established by the Club.

Parking

- 1. Cars will be not permitted on the Club's parking lot unless car stickers are pasted visibility on cars and a fee paid.
- 2. All parking of members' and guests' cars is subject to parking fees as established by the Club.
- 3. Only cars with parking stickers pasted visibly on them will be valet parked on club slots b the Club's valet parkers, only. A car pass entitles members to have their car valet parked only, not to park themselves.
- 4. All parking of cars will be at members own risk. The Club will not be responsible for damages or theft of any car, or for any personal property left in cars of members or guests.
- 5. All parking regulations must be observed.

Accessories and Attire

- 1. No refrigerator, microwaves, appliances shall be kept or allowed in any of the cabanas or other Club buildings.
- 2. Furniture supplied by the Club will not be permitted to be placed upon the sand areas.
- 3. All personal property must be removed from the cabanas at the end of the season. Any property left will be disposed of by the Club without recourse.



Safety and Health Regulations

- 1. The manager of the Club or chief lifeguard my propose safety limits as to venturesome bathing risks and all rulings in this respect must be observed. Diving is at members own risk. All infants must be accompanied by a parent. Infants are not permitted in the pool with diapers.
- 2. Bathing is prohibited at all times seaward of the jetties. Rafts, air mattresses, surfboards, and similar devices are not permitted o be brought into the Club premises or used on the beach or in the pool.
- 3. Members and guests shall not throw refuse upon Beach Club property or upon the adjoining properties. All refuse and waste matter must be deposited in the litter basket placed on the Beach Club premises for that purpose.
- 4. No cooking will be allowed in the cabanas or on the beach or in the cabana courts. No cooking electrical appliances may be brought into the Club premises or kept in cabanas.
- 5. No firearms, dogs, or other animals shall be taken or kept upon Club properties or beach areas.
- 6. Members and guests must not throw matches, cigars, cigarettes, or pipe ashes upon the wooden flooring of the Club and no candles or oil lamps shall be used on Club property.
- 7. The isles, paths, and passageways in the Club shall not be constructed by members or used by them for any other purposes than entrances or exits.
- 8. Children shall not be allowed to ride bicycles or toys or play on any walls, paths in the Club area.
- 9. Positively no eating, basket or lunch parties will be permitted on the patios.
- 10. Private swimming lessons must be approved and paid for through the management office.

Miscellaneous

- 1. All complaints must be made to the management.
- 2. No signs, notices, or advertising matter shall be placed upon any buildings or property of the Club, except by written permission.
- No members, guests, and, or employees shall be permitted to solicit for any trade or to receive commission from any tradesman or member. Under penalty or forfeiture of membership or dismissal.
- 4. No noisy, disorderly conduct, annoyance or disturbance to the management or the management or the members of the Club shall be permitted on any part of club property.
- 5. The Board of Governors shall have the right to suspend or expel any member for conduct which, in it opinion, is prejudicial to the best interests of the Club. Suspended members will have the privilege of appearing before the board before final action is taken.
- 6. A service charge for attendance may be charged by the Club.
- 7. The Board of Governors reserves the right to change, add to, suspend, or withdraw any or all of these rules and regulations at any time that, in its judgment, the best interest of the Club requires.
- 8. The Club management has the right to close the facility, including the pool and private beach on days when it is raining at 12 noon.
